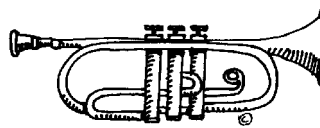

This free class provides an opportunity for students who do not have access to a band program at their school. It is not intended to replace instruction delivered by school band directors. Instruments and supplies are provided by the Hawaii Youth Symphony and the Music Center of Hawaii. The course is geared towards beginners or those with little experience on a band instrument, and will teach students how to play an instrument alone and in an ensemble, basic note reading, articulation and rhythm. Students are expected to attend class on a regular basis to ensure satisfactory progress is made, and will perform in two formal concerts in December and April.

### **How Do I Register?**

Space is limited. The Boys & Girls Club Band is a FREE music program but requires Boys & Girls Club membership at \$1/year. Membership allows you into any Boys & Girls Clubhouse on Oahu, six days a week. Applications are available at [www.HiYouthSymphony.org](http://www.HiYouthSymphony.org).
